## Guidelines for Recommendation Letter

### *Youth Leadership in China 2026*

As part of the application process for the Youth Leadership in China 2026, students are required to submit one letter of recommendation. The letter can be written by:

- A faculty member in a public or private school (e.g., subject teacher, school counselor, or principal).
- An after-school program teacher or private instructor who has worked with the student in an educational setting.

### Important Notes:

- There is no specific form to fill out for the recommendation.
- The recommendation letter should be **1-2 pages long** with official letterhead
- Please request teachers to submit recommendation letters directly to this email: [ylc@chinainstitute.org](mailto:ylc@chinainstitute.org),
- Please include the **student's name** in both the title of the recommendation letter and the email subject line.

### Guidelines for Teachers to Include in the Letter of Recommendation:

#### 1. Reasons for why the student would be a good candidate for this program:

Reasons may include but are not limited to the students' personal strengths and qualities such as good sense of responsibility, adaptability, curiosity, leadership, teamwork skills, etc.

#### 2. Provide specific examples demonstrating the students' qualities:

Share instances where the student has demonstrated an interest in learning, cultural understanding, or community involvement.

#### 3. How would the student benefit from participating in this program:

Explain how the student's skills, interests, and experiences align with the goals of the Youth Leadership in China 2026.
